The World of Work is Changing! Skills are Changing!

RAPID URBANIZATION



- >50% of the population live in urban areas
- I.5 million people are added to the global urban population every week
- 90% of the urban population growth will take place in African and Asian countries
- Placing huge demands on infrastructure, services, job creation, climate and environment
- Opportunities for business activities, productivity, knowledge sharing, economic development
- Challenges for national and local governments

CLIMATE CHANGE & RESOURCE SCARCITY



- Average temperatures are predicted to increase by more than 2 degrees Celsius
- The growing global population is expected to demand 35% more food by 2030
- Demand for energy and water is forecast to increase by 50% and 40% respectively by 2030
- Climate change will reduce agricultural productivity over the next 60 years
- Sea levels are rising faster 2 meters by the end of the century
- Only 3% of the world's water is freshwater > physical water scarcity by 2025 according to the International Water Management Institute.
- Opportunities: growth in alternative energy, transition to a low-carbon economy, new types of
 jobs in alternative energy, new engineering processes, product design, and waste management
 and re-use
- Challenges: restructuring of traditional energy industries, corporate social responsibility

TECHNOLOGICAL BREAKTHROUGHS




- Automation, Robotics, Al, Blockchain, Drones, Internet of Things, Virtual Reality

DEMOGRAPHIC AND SOCIAL CHANGE



- World population is ageing putting pressure on business, social institutions and economies
- Increase of population in Africa (double by 2050)
- Older workers will need to learn new skills and work for longer
- Empowering young people will be critical
- Inequality will be rised > the world's 8 richest people now own as much wealth as the poorest half of the world's population.
- Women in work greater female participation in higher levels- haning fewer children later in life


