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Working Team:

This policy mandates annual training on sustainability principles, ensuring compliance with best practices and contributing to the university's strategic goal of improving its QS Sustainability Ranking.

Objectives

The training policy aims to:

- Enhance awareness and understanding of environmental sustainability among university staff.
- Ensure compliance with national and international sustainability regulations.
- Promote sustainable practices across all university departments and operations.
- Support Mutah University's commitment to improving its QS Sustainability Ranking.
- Foster a culture of sustainability through active staff participation.
- Encourage innovation and leadership in environmental sustainability within the university community.

Scope

This policy applies to all faculty, administrative, and support staff at Mutah University. Training will be conducted annually and integrated into the university's professional development framework. Additionally, specialized training modules will be available for specific roles that directly impact sustainability outcomes, such as facility management and procurement.

Training Content

The training program will cover the following key topics:

1. **Sustainability Fundamentals:** Understanding climate change, carbon footprint, and the importance of sustainability in academic institutions.
2. **Energy Efficiency:** Best practices in energy conservation, renewable energy adoption, and reducing the university's carbon footprint.
3. **Waste Management:** Recycling programs, waste reduction strategies, circular economy principles, and hazardous waste disposal.
4. **Water Conservation:** Efficient water use, pollution prevention, and strategies for reducing water consumption.

Training Implementation

Delivery Methods:

- Online modules and interactive e-learning courses.

Mandatory Participation:

- All staff must complete the annual training as part of their performance evaluation.

- Key performance indicators (KPIs) related to training completion rates and sustainability impact will be monitored to measure effectiveness.

Continuous Improvement

- Mutah University will review and update the training program annually to incorporate the latest sustainability trends, technological advancements, and regulatory changes.
- Feedback from participants will be systematically collected to improve content delivery and engagement.
- The university will collaborate with external sustainability experts, academic institutions, and industry leaders to enhance training quality.
- Sustainability research outcomes and best practices will be integrated into future training modules to ensure a cutting-edge approach.
