

• Abstracts should not exceed (400) words and should be written in Times New Roman, font 12. Five Keywords reflecting the content of the presentation should be written at the bottom of the abstract page.

• The researcher must state the following on the abstract page: the title of the research, their name, academic rank, and the institution they are affiliated with.

• The participant must complete the participation form and submit it along with the abstract.

• A copy of the researcher's CV, limited to one page, must be submitted along with the abstract.

• The scientific committee of the conference will be responsible for reviewing the abstracts on a rolling basis starting from the date of submission and up to  $20^{\text{th}}$  of January.

• The committee has the right to accept or reject the submission.
